- Jupiter has three rings



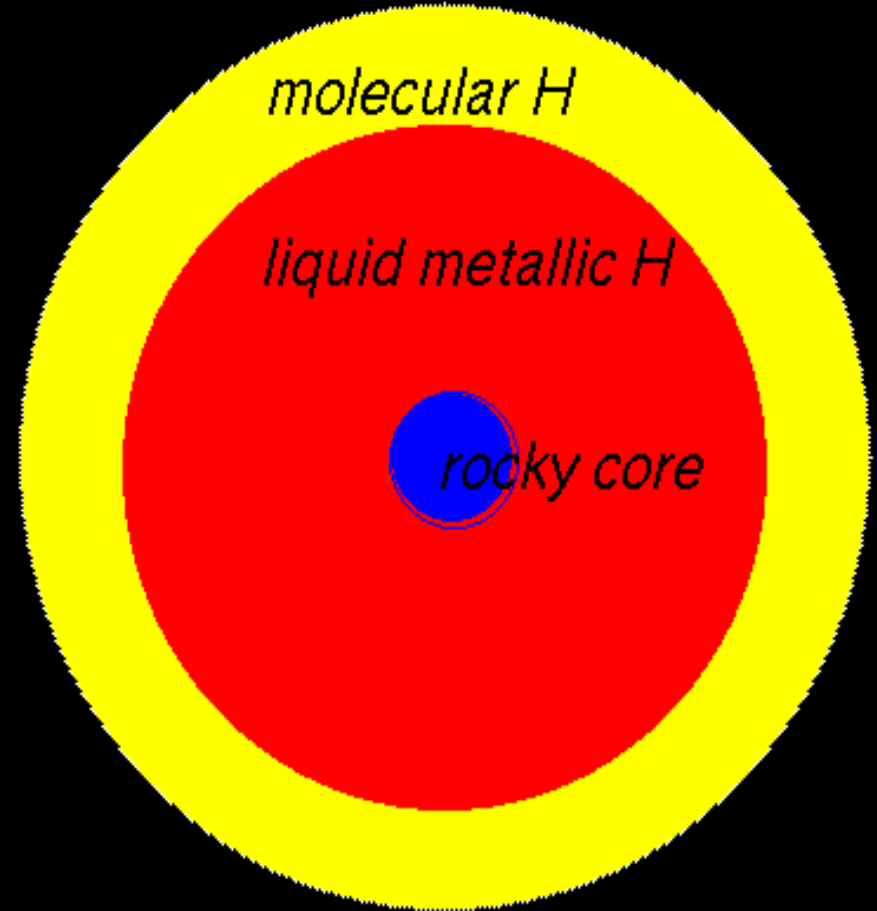
# Discovery of Jupiter

- # Distance = 483,780,000 miles



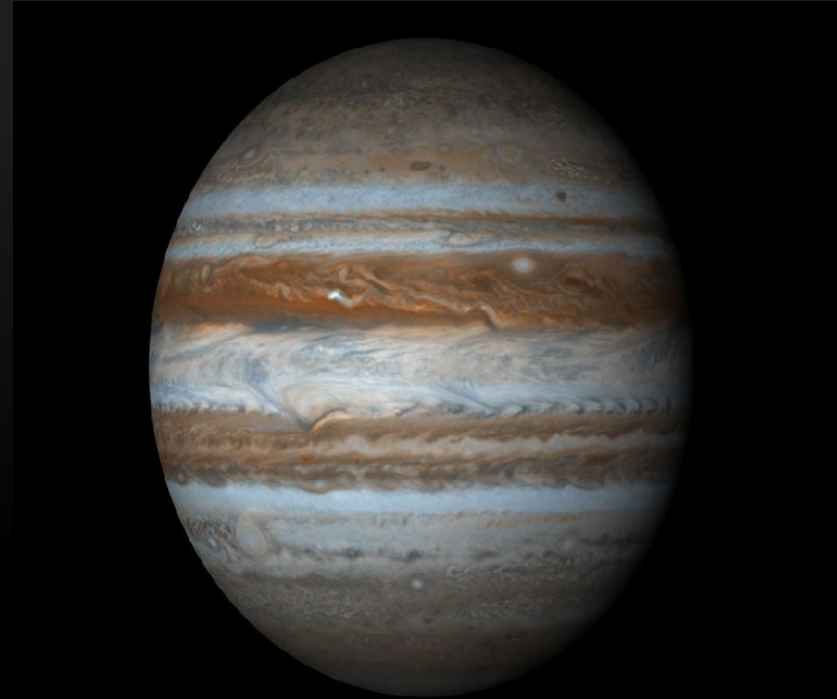
# Is it suitable for humans?
