Behaviors to Notice and Teach at the Next Level

Process long sentences with embedded clauses(prepositional phrases, introductory clauses)	Use the content of a sentence, paragraph, or whole text to determine the meaning of a word
Demonstrate competent, active word solving	Understand longer descriptive words
Self-correct when errors detract from the meaning of the text	When reading aloud, self-correct intonation when it does not reflect the meaning
Notice new and interesting words and actively add them to speaking or writing vocabulary	Process sentences with a series of nouns, verbs, or adverbs
Read silently and orally at an appropriate rate	Summarize ideas from text and tell how they are related
Specify the nature of the connection (topic, content, type of story, writer)	Read dialogue with phrasing and expression that reflects understanding of characters and events
Infer cause and effect in influencing characters' feelings or underlying motives	Infer causes of problems and outcomes
Identify important aspects of illustration (design related to the meaning of the text)	Bring background content knowledge to the understanding of a text before, during and after
Understand the relationship between setting and plot	Identify significant events and tell how they are related to the problem of the story or the solution
